Nicolas Kristof, writing in *The New York Times*, argues, **"If we're serious about promoting equality, we can champion early childhood education programs: To get more kids in a university, invest in pre-K."** (*NYT* 7/30/23)

**EPAK expanded its reach to do just that by giving grants directly to teachers in pre-K through high school in East Palo Alto and eastern Menlo Park.** All Five Preschool, in the EPAK family of schools, states on its own website, "Research shows that 80% of brain development happens by age three. Between the ages of three and five years old, children are wired to make huge gains in language, mathematics, and critical thinking."
